Match Scoring

A fall terminates any match; otherwise, a decision is awarded based on points earned. If the contestants are tied at the end of the three regular periods, they will wrestle overtime. Overtime will consist of a one-minute sudden victory period, and if needed two 30-second tiebreakers. If the score remains tied at the end of the two 20-second tiebreakers, a 30 second ultimate tiebreaker shall take place.

A wrestler earns team points by placing 1-6 in his weight class. Team totals will be posted at the end of each round, with minimum points being awarded as soon as they are earned. Example: A wrestler advancing to the semi-finals is guaranteed at least 6th place finish, so those points are awarded after the quarter-final round.

In addition, a wrestler earns two advancement points for each bout won in the Championship Bracket (not including the Finals) and one advancement point for each bout in the Consolation Bracket (not including the final placement bouts).

The following points are earned based on the margin of decision in each bout won.

Fall, Forfeit, Default or Disqualification 2
Technical Fall 1.5
Major Decision 1

Awards

The Heb Evans Trophy, awarded to the ISL Dual Meet Champions, will be presented prior to the finals.

Place awards for each weight will be presented at the conclusion of the final bout in the next weight.

Tournament Trophies and other awards will be made at the conclusion of the tournament.

Team Championship Award, Second Place Team

Gibby Graves- Buckingham Browne and Nichols' coach and pioneer in developing tournament. While Gibby coached, his wife "sister" was more than just a loyal fan. She was always the "matchmaker" for all the early meetings.

Bert Kelsey- Roxbury Latin Coach with 24 winning seasons and numerous individual championships from 1937-1966. Bert joined the sports of body and mind in the ancient Greek concept. As a teacher of English debate and wrestling, his boundless energy and gruff good nature endeared him to hundreds of students.

Wilbur Storer Outstanding Wrestler Award

Wilbur Storer- As a wrestling coach, Athletic Director and Science Department Chair at Noble and Greenough, Wilbur had a profound influence on many students. He was concerned not only in a student's academic and athletic performance but also in his development into a man.

Louis Andrews Trophy for Most Falls in the Least Time

Louis Andrews- Milton Wrestling Coach, 1934-1965, with a career record of 165-57-4. He built boys who had everything into champions. He took the boy with almost nothing and gave him something.

David Coe Trophy for the Most Improved Team

David Coe- St. Mark's coach and Athletic Director, 1933-1969, holds the St. Mark's record for consecutive athletic victories with 29 wrestling wins from 1948-1952. "Regardless of the outcome measured by victories and defeats, I know many young men will profit immeasurably from the sport of wrestling".

Heb Evans Trophy- ISL Dual Meet Champion

Heb Evans- The Governor's Academy wrestling and lacrosse mentor for 35 years. His warmth and caring for his students both in his math classroom and in athletics will always be remembered.
